## PREP YOUR YARD FOR SPRING

## QUESO DIP

**Ingredients:**

- 3/4 block of velveta Cheese - Prefer- Velveta -or 24 White American Cheese slices
- 1 can Rotel Original Diced Tomatos & Green Chilies
- 1 empty Rotel can - fill with water/beef stock/ chicken stock/veggie stock or beer (as in, the amount of liquid)
- 1.5 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- 1 teaspoon Chili powder
- 1.5 teaspoon cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 tsp smoked paprika
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 8-10 pickled jalapeño slices

**Steps:**

1. Crumble cheese into a blender.
2. Bring all of the other ingredients (except jalapeños) to a boil and pour over the cheese in the blender.
3. Blend until smooth.
4. Add the jalapeños and blend again. Makes 40 liquid ounces of dip. Serve hot or cold.
